For all students: check the map of the core area before applying...

Travelling on a Sanders or Our Hire bus

Students can choose between applying for a discount card entitling you to a £3.20 daily fare (or £2.70 if on a qualifying benefit) OR can pay £564 or £423 if in receipt of benefits which can be paid Half termly / Termly / Annually for a pre paid pass.

Travelling on the 808 bus from Acle

Students can pay £564 or £423 if in receipt of benefits which can be paid Half termly / Termly / Annually for a pre paid pass. (Travel can include feeder services (730/68/72A) from villages feeding into Acle)

Travelling by train/minibus

Pre paid passes available only. Alternatively contact Greater Anglia for details of Scholar tickets which in many cases are better value than applying to NCC.

- > Students can pay the normal fare on the buses if they don't have a pass.
- > Download the village list to see what transport is provided from where you live.

Notes:

- Only bus passes can be offered from Norwich
- Only bus passes on service 33 can be offered from Cromer
- Only train passes can be offered from Wroxham, Salhouse, Rackheath
- Only pre-paid passes can be offered on certain services, check village list.

➤ If you are applying from the Acle catchment area and you don't live in Acle, choose Acle as your boarding point and you will receive an additional pass which covers the feeder service into Acle. See timetables for details of these services.

➤ If you are a new student and where you live is not on the boarding point list, you need to make your own arrangements to get to the most appropriate place to you.
