








When to apply

Students/parents can complete an application for the Bursary for travel assistance prior to enrolment. This will speed up the application process once enrolled with us. Online application forms will be available to complete from July 2021.

Applications for the Post 16 Transport Scheme usually open at Easter, with applications being made through the council for the bus pass.

Greater Anglia update their website regularly, and will be able to advise on the best time to apply.

Train

`16+ or Scholar' train tickets are available only from Greater Anglia – the number for enquiries is **0345 600 7245** option 3 then option 2. You will need to obtain a photo card from a main station prior to phoning.

Bus

Transport to Paston is both convenient and affordable, with North Walsham being well served by both bus routes and train services. The train station is just a short 5 minute walk from college and connects services from Norwich to Cromer, Sheringham and Runton on the coast.


Getting to Paston

We believe that every young person should be able to study at College, if they want to and it is right for them. We are serious about transport and do all we can to make it easy to travel to study at Paston.

Students are encouraged to take advantage of the Norfolk County Council (NCC) Post 16 Transport Scheme

If you're aged 16 or 17 you can now enjoy 50% off Anytime, Off-Peak, Advance and Season tickets E.g. opportunities for reduced rail fares linked to Greater Anglia's 16+ Scholar tickets and 16-17 Saver Railcards which may be cheaper than the NCC subsidised rate, particularly from stations on the Norwich to Sheringham line.



Travel from the 'core' area

The core route area includes for example: East Runton, Cromer, Aylsham, Stalham, Wroxham/Hoveton, Hemsby, Rackheath, Coltishall and Horstead. Further information and details can be found on the County Council or college website. Travel from locations within this area is organised by Norfolk County Council and full details are available on their website. All buses stop near to the College making journeys convenient and comfortable. Again please check rates linked to Greater Anglia's Scholar deals which might be more convenient.

A full annual payment for the Post 16 Transport Scheme is currently £564 for 2021/22, with options to pay in termly instalments to offer flexibility and spread the cost.

Travel from outside the 'core' area

We have a large and growing number of students travelling to Paston from a wide range of destinations throughout Norfolk.

Travel from North Norwich, Acle, Yarmouth, Sheringham and Holt areas is currently organised through Norfolk County Council (see above).

Travel to Paston from Norwich and beyond is easy with Greater Anglia's 16+ or Scholar's tickets. As an example the current price (August 2020) for a 16+ ticket from Norwich to North Walsham is £746 per year, from Salhouse £509.10 and Sheringham £410 per year. A Scholar's ticket for travel from the wider area (Anglia Plus ticket) beyond Norwich is available. If you contact Greater Anglia they can advise you on the cheapest option at the time.

Students in low income households with earnings of £24,000 or less can apply to the 16-19 bursary, and may be awarded help towards the costs of travel – see the online bursary application here: **www.paston.ac.uk/support-and-advice/finance**
